The Duck Creek office is located in the Seaport District, a short 10-minute ride from Logan International Airport.

Arrival Procedure

Guests should check in with lobby security at Duck Creek's Boston Wharf Road building. Once you have checked in, there is a kiosk with a touch screen located to the left of the security desk. Please sign-in and enter the person's name that you are here to see. Security will send you up to the 10th floor where your host will greet you. If no one is at the security desk, your host will come down to the lobby to greet you.

Transportation/Parking

Taxi or Uber is the recommended mode of transportation, as parking in the area is expensive and everything you need is within walking distance of the office and hotels. Public transportation is recommended within commuting distance. The Duck Creek office is a 10-minute walk from South Station, a major transportation hub, and one block from the nearest Silver Line stop (Courthouse Station).

FAQs

What time do classes begin and end?

Typically, classes are held from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm with an hour lunch break and short breaks in the mid-morning and mid-afternoon. Trainers are available during breaks and after class to answer questions and to help individual students. Please note the starting time of your class as start times may vary and plan on arriving a few minutes early so that you can set up your workstation and be ready for a prompt start to class.

Some classes are scheduled for early dismissal on Fridays so that students can catch flights home. If you are flying out of Logan International Airport, you should plan to fly no earlier than 5:30 pm, and should plan to leave the office two hours before your flight to allow for possible traffic. Please inform your instructor at the beginning of the week if you will need to leave early on Friday for a flight.

What is the dress code in your building?

Business casual (including jeans) is encouraged. We want each guest to dress comfortably while they are here.

What materials and technology are provided?

Students should bring their own laptop, power cord, and mouse to class. Duck Creek University provides each student with a virtual development environment for all hands-on classes, and all materials needed for the course are stored in the virtual environment. A guest network provides internet access for visitors.
